TOXFREE CLEAN UP THE ABROLHOS ISLANDS

The issue

The Abrolhos Islands is a group of 122 coral cays that lie scattered across 100 kilometres of the Indian Ocean to the west of Geraldton. Over time, rubbish builds up around the islands and for several years Perth Friends of the Abrolhos (PFA) have been visiting to clean up the mess.

The solution

Toxfree joined with PFA to help them in their clean-up mission of the Islands. The collection took place across five days and the team of 12 volunteers collected 4.08 tonnes of rubbish in 407 Toxfree rubbish bags from 8 of the islands. The Eco Abrolhos vessel was used to ferry the haul back to Geraldton for treatment and disposal.



The outcome

Toxfree was delighted to be able to help in the clean-up of the Islands. It was a great team building exercise as well as a chance to make a difference.
