TrainRight was established in 2013 by Ethan Leeds. Ethan a former Toxfree employee has an extensive background in Industrial Services having worked and trained extensively on most equipment including vacuum loaders, drain cleaning and High Pressure Water Jetting applications.

Ethan's vision for TrainRight is to deliver Nationally Accredited training to the industry, arming operators with the best knowledge and skills to work more efficiently and safely.

This year Toxfree were recognised as ABA100 Winner in the Australian Business Awards for Innovation for their "Train Right – Let's Communicate" initiative where an experienced trainer operator can communicate directly through headsets with the operator during "real time" duties.

The initiative was designed and developed in the field by the Toxfree Industrial Services team and TrainRight. The initiative is a relatively simple and novel approach to ensuring communications are enhanced when undertaking industrial service activities, predominantly when undertaking training and skill verification in high noise environments.
