TOXFREE OFFERS A SERVICE PACKAGE TO DISPOSE OF MERCURY CONTAINING LAMPS

Toxfree is one of only two companies in Australia with the equipment to safely separate and recycle the various components of mercury containing lamps. Toxfree is a truly a national packaged hazardous chemical waste operation.



The issue

As a founding signatory of Fluorocycle, KP Lighting Pty Ltd are committed to diverting waste from landfill. In order to achieve this, Toxfree were asked to put together a national service package for all States and Territories in Australia as part of KP Lightings sustainability commitment to Woolworths.

The solution

Toxfree provided dedicated metal stillages for storage of the spent lamps at KP Lighting premises with appropriately licenced vehicles to transport the waste to our facilities in each State or Territory for further processing.

The outcome

Toxfree is providing these services on a national basis for KP Lighting, helping both KP Lighting and Woolworths to achieve their sustainability objectives.

Toxfree is doing their part to reduce a major source of mercury contamination (the dumping of spent lamps in landfill). There are however, more than 90% of lamps which are still not being recycled.
